illustrations from a children's  
book. Scratchboard is a hard  
Masonite clay-coated board  
sprayed over with black India ink.  
The subject is drawn on the  
surface from tracing paper  
smeared with chalk by pencil.  
Then it's scratched by an x-acto  
knife which an image of white  
appears. The art is a result of  
white art on a black surface.  
It has an ancestry that goes back  
hundreds of years.
