GAL members can bring one piece of art - wired for hanging (NO saw tooth hangers) to the Book Market at **11:30 Tues, July 5th**. A reception will be held on **Friday, July 22, 6-8 p**. This is a great time to see all the talent in the art league! Please bring one plated snack item to share and friends and neighbors. We're featuring a People's Choice Award again.

EXHIBIT CHANGEOVER week starts on **Tues, July 5th**. You will be contacted by your gallery manager for the specific day/time. Be sure your work is wired for hanging. (*NO saw tooth hangers at any locations*)

If you're not an exhibiting artist at SAF, then you can also bring one piece of art to show in the GLENVIEW'S OWN tent, which will be judged for prizes. Art cannot be larger than 36" any dimension, including the frame and cannot weigh more than 12 lbs and must also be wired for hanging. Bring your art on Sat, July 30th at 10: a and pick it up on Sun, July 31 between 4-5 p. If you can stay to help hang the work, please let Kittie know.

Many of you entered the NATURE IN GLENVIEW ART COMPETITION, which will be shown in its own tent at SAF as well. If you entered, bring your piece **on Sat July 30 at 10 a and pick it up Sun July 31 between 4-5 p**. wired for hanging..NO SAW TOOTH. This tent will also be judged for prizes. Nearly all entries were accepted and letters will be sent next week with details of the dates and times to drop work at the Park Center in Aug and the library in Sept. Artists must participate in all the exhibits. Can you do *a little thing* like help hang this tent? Contact me or Kittie.
