October 4th Demo is preceded by the Annual Members' Meeting with election of board members. Thank you to all board members for their time, energy, and commitment to keeping GAL a vibrant organization. See the slate of Directors and Officers in this newsletter. Thank you to *Lindsay Brown* who is unable to continue as a board member due to some family obligations.

Each year we evaluate activities and begin planning for the upcoming year. Financially we have done better than the last several years, but our costs will be changing in 2017, so we need to *adjust our sails*. The board investigated the fees of other area art leagues and decided to keep Membership Dues the same, but we need to increase SAF fees to offset increased costs to us and bring us more in line with other leagues.

While we were approved as a Recognized Organization with the Park District, it no longer includes free services. Demo rooms need to be rented and labor for SAF set up will be charged. So, we are looking into an alternate location for demos and increasing sponsors and donations for SAF. The Glenview Chamber of Commerce will also be co-sponsoring SAF

with us next year. GAL will be partnering with JourneyCare to oversee their Gallery Management. It is good to add more community Partnerships like this will be a great opportunity to learn about managing a gallery space. *Barb Zabroske & Deb Anderson* will be overseeing this program, but if you are able to help a few hours with phone calls or during receptions or changeovers, contact them. This partnership will also give us free use of their atrium for our Pot Luck on Dec 2 as well as a training room for demos, which will be there in Feb.

*The Nature in Glenview Art Competition* is now on display at the Glenview Public Library. A reception will be held in Oct date TBD. There has been much public interest in this exhibit, but in order to continue this program next year, we need 2 volunteers to oversee the competition.

Watch for membership renewal and exhibit forms to your mailbox in Oct and be sure to keep checking off ways in which you can help. As we *change direction* next year, please *adjust your sails* along with us to keep GAL moving forward as a vital part of the community!
