Major construction at Lyon School will present some new challenges with parking and layout of the fair. We are looking for additional volunteers to assist visitors and artists. Let's ***overwhelm*** Glenview with a quality art fair in spite of extra limitations this year! As always, we need volunteers to:

1. Hang the ***Glenview's Own Tent*** and the Art Competition Tent from 8:30-11a on Sat, July 29.
2. Oversee the hospitality area.
3. Volunteers all weekend. Sign up for 2 hours or as long as you like. Various activities need help depending on your interests and abilities - Silent Auction, Info booth, welcome visitors, direct parking at the bank. Contact Kittie Yohe if you can help.
4. We need Silent Auction donations. If you have a favorite merchant, send me their contact info and GAL will contact them for a donation if you're uncomfortable asking. This

is our only fund-raiser and donations are tax-deductible, so we'd like to boost donations and income. ***Your little bit*** of help is much appreciated and spreads the work load to many hands.

***Overwhelm*** Glenview with your talents in these ways.

1. GAL members can ***share a tent*** at SAF, so grab a friend and send us an application. If you're not in the SAF as an artist, you can display one piece of your work, no larger than 36" any dimension, including the frame in the Glenview's Own Tent. ***Entries cannot be previously shown*** in the GVO Tent and will be judged for prizes. Drop off work at 10a on Sat, July 29, and pick up on Sun, July 30, after 4p.

2. The ***Nature in Glenview Art Competition*** is on and the deadline of ***June 15*** is fast approaching. Download an application: <http://glenviewartleague.org/wp-content/uploads/2014/11/Art-Competition-app-p2-1.pdf>. Photography will be accepted this year. All submissions will be exhibited at Journey Care during August. Top entries will be exhibited at SAF and judged for prizes. Select entries will be on display at the Glenview Library Sept 15-Nov 15 with an artist reception in early Oct. Select entries will also be exhibited at the Glenview Park Center Nov-Dec. Artists need to drop off and pick up their work wherever they are selected to exhibit. If you can help jury the entries, let me know.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION- Nature in Glenview Art Competition**

All 2 dimensional media accepted.

Work not to exceed 24" any dimension, including the frame.

Up to 30 pieces of art will be selected by a Glenview Art League jury for exhibit at their Annual Outdoor Summer Art Fair, July 29-30, 2017 and be judged for cash awards.

Selected works will also be exhibited at the Glenview Park Center in August, and the Glenview Public Library mid-September through mid-November with a reception in October.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

Open to anyone high school age or older. Only one entry per artist.

Digital images should be no larger than 1920x1920 pixels and labelled as such: Last name\_Initial\_Title and can be emailed to [glenviewartleague@att.net](mailto:glenviewartleague@att.net) or postal mailed to the address below.

The quality of images submitted will also be taken into consideration by the judges.

Art needs to reflect a specific location in the community of Glenview.

### **DEADLINES**

All applications, entry fees, and images must be postmarked by June 15, 2017.

Artists selected to exhibit at the Summer Art Fair need to bring their work to Lyon School, 1335

Waukegan Road, Glenview on Saturday, July 29th at 9 a.m. and pick up work on Sun July 30th at 4 pm.

Selected artists must drop off and pick up their work for all exhibits on times/dates given. Work exhibited must be the work submitted to the competition – no substitutions permitted.

Any sales are between the buyer and artist only. No commission will be taken.

### **FEES**

There is a \$20 entry fee which should be included with the application. Surplus fees will be donated to the Glenview Art League, a 501c3 tax-exempt organization.
