Saturday was the 26th annual Youth Art Fair which featured the work of 223 students from kindergarten through high school, representing 42 schools as well as home schooling. It is always amazing to see the level of talent and the variety of mediums. Viewers and judges often question whether the work has been done solely by the student. Some works of art seem beyond the ability of a child of a specific age. I heard more than one person comment that one of the kindergarten paintings was the <u>best</u> one in the show - but she was only in kindergarten!

Consider Aelita Andre of Australia who had her first exhibit at the age of 24 months - yes, as a toddler! Her work was grabbed up by an art gallery for exhibition without knowing her age. At the age of 7 (2014), she painted live in front of 20,000 people in the LDS Concert Hall in Salt Lake City, Utah. She loved the audience attention and played a real violin while painting as it was glued to the canvas.
