*professional artists in their studios after a career in nursing. "I've been painting now for about 20 years and my preferred medium is **oil**." "I have a preference for portraiture, but am currently working on a series of sunrises and sunsets. I'm not*

interested in being photorealistic, but rather using color and varying techniques with paint to create a mood and evoke a feeling in the viewer. I often begin my paintings with a palette knife as well as using it to lay on thick paint in the foreground or to create texture."
