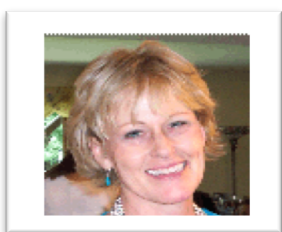
this year was SPRING - we walked out into falling snow!

Tuesday, May 1st - Yvonne Wolfe is GAL's Demo Artist!



Gong bi brush painting art is a meticulous work of fine art. A tradition over 2000 years old, it has clear rules that communicate social and cultural values that are still relevant today. These paintings communicate prosperity and fulfillment in a highly balanced relationship. Yvonne will show three typical motifs: *flower and birds, animal and trees, and landscape*, and how to appreciate these works applying the principles of yin yang.

Yvonne was raised in a family where Chinese arts and culture were very much celebrated. After school hours were spent watching her aunt, a gong bi (工笔画) brush painter, paint Chinese fine brush paintings, visiting the Palace Museum, watching Beijing Opera, shadow puppet shows, and listening to Chinese storytellers. Her father was an English teacher at the National Taiwan Normal University (The Teachers' Academy) and a Chinese teacher in an American university. After her family emigrated from Taiwan to the US at age 8, she continued to learn Chinese at home. Yvonne enjoys art in many forms and has found many similarities between Chinese and western art forms. She explains Chinese arts and culture in a way that American audiences can easily relate.
