The Glenview Art League, in cooperation with the Glenview Public Library, will sponsor the fourth-annual, small-canvas art exhibition and contest this September. The art theme of the contest will be, "Water, Water Everywhere". Canvases measuring 6 inches by 6 inches will be handed out, free, to the first 100 contestants. Each contestant will have 10 weeks to complete their piece of art and return it to the library for exhibition, in the library's lobby, from September through November. All completed canvases will be judged on their quality and how well each entry follows the theme. All contestants must be 18 years of age or older.

The GAL is now accepting applications for the 2023 Robert Sherman Fine Art Scholarship. Interested high school seniors should submit an application with images of 10 pieces of artwork by April 12, 2023. March Art Demonstration Recap

Rashmi Banagere Ranganath shared her intuitive approach to acrylic mixed media paintings at our March Art Demo event. Her artwork is often inspired by poetry or music. Favorite materials include various types of acrylic paint, especially Golden fluid acrylics. She uses gel medium for collage, and modeling paste with stencils to create raised effects. She collects tissue paper, napkins, even used dryer sheets to develop interesting textures.

During the demo she covered a canvas with marks and collaged elements. She demonstrated how layers of transparent color pull the painting together, harmonizing the marks. This rich surface became the base for a composition that included a figure and floral forms. She used strong contrasts of color, value and texture to draw the eye through the composition.
