

Christiane Bouret will participate in the Skokie Art Guild Spring exhibit at the Devonshire Cultural Center, 4400 Greenwood St., Skokie. The exhibit ends July 14. Kay had attended the Society's first show at the Nippon Club in New York City in 1963. After moving to the Chicago area in 1972, Kay began teaching Asian arts and crafts for both adults and children. There was so much interest that she established a branch of the National Sumi-e Society called Sumi-e Midwest. They celebrate their 40th anniversary last year.
