## Busey Bank 1868 Exhibition

### *Call for Art*

The Glenview Art League and Busey Bank are thrilled to announce a new art exhibit, **1868 The Exhibition**, to be displayed in Busey's Downtown Glenview service center located at 800 Waukegan Rd in Glenview. Each piece will be for sale, with 100% of purchasing price going to the artist. A digital exhibition will also be available on Busey.com.

Busey Bank is looking to showcase the work of multiple local artists with the Glenview Art League chosen through a jury selection process. All selected pieces will be displayed from January 2024 through June 2024. The service center is currently open from 8:30 a.m.-5 p.m., Monday-Friday or Saturday 8:30 a.m.-1 p.m. for artists who would like to view the specific wall site and surrounding area. **Please note that display areas will be located in between the first floor and mezzanine level.**

**Deadline submission is 11:59 p.m. on Monday, November 6.**

Late work will not be considered. Selected artists will be contacted on before November 30 with further instructions. The date for the opening reception is tentatively scheduled for early 2024.

*Monday, Oct. 9: All Members Meeting and Demonstration by artist Tim Erickson*

The Glenview Art League welcomes artist Tim Erickson to demonstrate weaving techniques and share his artwork on Oct. 9, at 7 p.m. in the Glenview Public Library’s Community Room East.

Erickson’s art practice has been a pursuit of understanding his cultural identity through discovery and research of indigenous Bolivian weaving practices, culminating in a three year study of the traditions, techniques, symbolic and spiritual meanings of Bolivian weaving.

His artwork is influenced in part by the global waste-pollution crisis. Waste appears as a critical medium in nearly all of his artistry. He often use discarded materials such as clothing, mophead braids, and plastic shipping straps. He shares, “My objective is to rediscover the native weaving traditions of my people and pass down this treasure of Bolivian heritage to a new generation.”

***Our artist demonstrations are free and open to the public. This event is ADA accessible.***

The October demo will be preceded by a short **All Members meeting** where GAL members will vote on the 2024 Board of Directors. A selection of art supplies donated by the family of former GAL president Don Scholz will be available first-come, first serve, free of charge.

*Busey Bank 1868 Exhibition Requirements*

- Each artist may submit up to 3 images of original work for consideration
- All 2D mediums will be considered
- Submissions must be appropriate for all viewing audiences
- No submission fee required
- Artwork must be no larger than 30 inches tall including frame (horizontal pieces preferred)
- Selected artwork must be ready to hang
- Artwork cannot weigh more than 40 pounds
- Artwork can be one individual piece or made up of multiple panels that are part of one cohesive piece and fit within the size requirements
- Building owners and/or management are not liable for any damage to selected art
- A contract will be signed by both parties upon art drop off
- All entries must be submitted online with this form (in person delivery of submissions to Busey Bank will not be accepted)
- This opportunity is available for members of the Glenview Art League
- **Artwork delivery to Busey Bank 800 Waukegan Rd** and pick up arrangements must be made by the artist upon acceptance

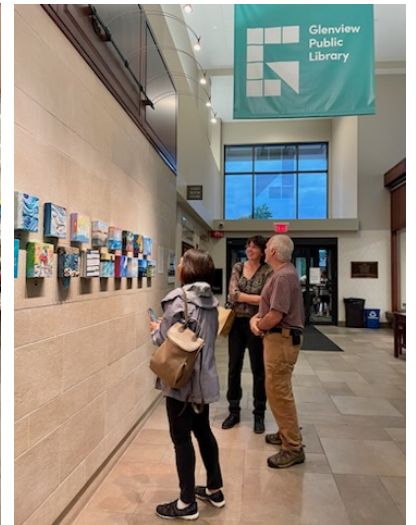
