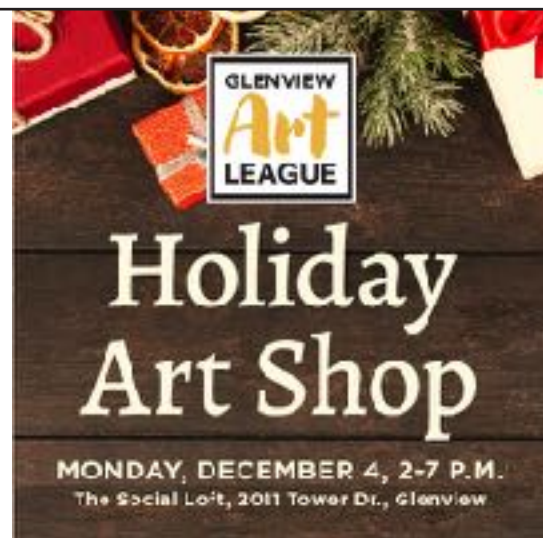
GAL Holiday Art Shop!

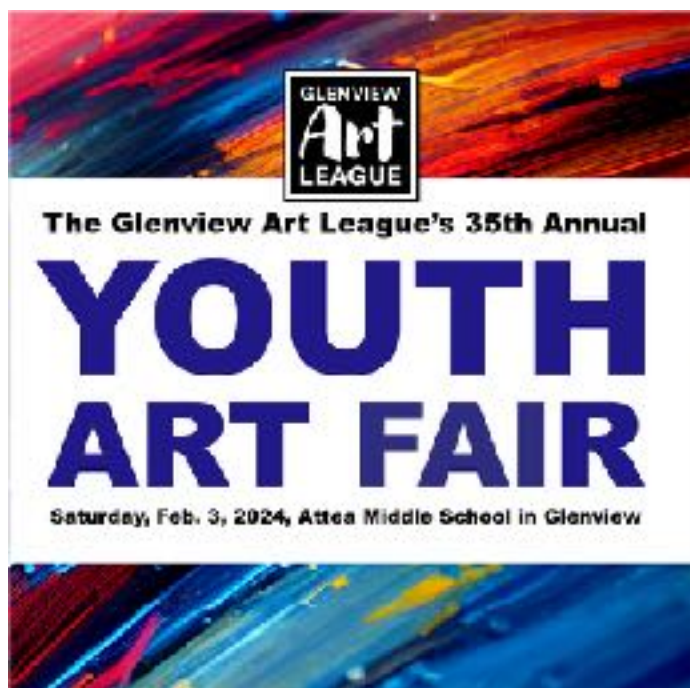
35th Annual Youth Art Fair
