- ___ **C & M Auto (3 months)**
1-person show with space for about 7-9 pieces of varying size
- ___ **Edward R James (Outer Lobby Northern Trust) (3 months)**
1-person show with space for 6 medium pieces and one larger piece
- ___ **Arden Courts (3 months)**
12-15 medium to large pieces. Changeover at 2 p.m.
- ___ **Colonial Dental (6 months)**
3 medium pieces in dental exam rooms with blue walls (1 vertical piece with a companion horizontal piece). Bring a variety, office managers help select the pieces to show.
- ___ **Tarantur (6 months)**
8-10 medium to large pieces
- ___ **Northbrook Court (6 months)**
Space for 5-6 artists, approximately 18 feet. Easels or other display material may be required.

NOTE: The Exhibit Committee reserves the right to decline work deemed unacceptable and/or replace artists unable to meet pre-set dates/times.
